TIME AND METHOD OF IDENTIFICATION.

Live puppies less than 16 weeks of age shall be identified. Twenty weaned puppies currently in kennel are not identified. A copy of Policy # 20 was discussed and left with owner. All weaned puppies need to be identified.

HOUSING FACILITIES, GENERAL.

(Drainage & waste disposal) . "Disposal and drainage systems must minimize vermin and pest infestation, insects, odors, and disease hazards. All drains must be properly constructed, installed, and maintained. If the facility uses sump or settlement ponds, or other similar systems for drainage and animal waste disposal, the system must be located far enough away from the animal area of the housing facility to prevent odors, diseases, pests, and vermin infestation." There is a waste pit five feet in front of outdoor runs and a large pool of water below pit. The pit has a temporary wooden top which is open on the sides. The pit needs a more solid top to prevent odors and insect problems. The area below the pit needs to be filled so that the standing water problem is eliminated.

PRIMARY ENCLOSURES.

Primary enclosures shall be constructed and maintained so that they have no sharp points or edges that could injure the dogs. The following enclosures need repair:

- 1) Outdoor enclosure housing the two Mastiffs has detached and bent tin on the partition fence.
- 2) Red outdoor enclosures housing cocker spaniel has rusty and broken wire on bottom of partition.

These two enclosures need to be repaired to prevent possible injury to the dogs.
