# RECORDS: DEALERS AND EXHIBITORS.

The official tag number is not recorded for 50 adult dogs and replacement breeders on Record of Acquisition and Dogs and Cats on Hand (APHIS form 7005). The puppy ID number was not recorded for puppies sold in 2002 on Record of Disposition of Dogs and Cats (APHIS form 7006). Identification numbers must be recorded for adults dogs on hand and all puppies sold.
